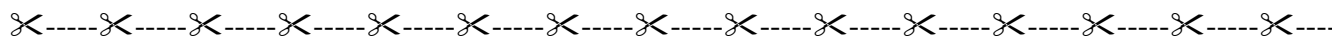

STUDENT BEHAVIORAL COMMITMENT

Temple Emanu-El Religious School expects its students to honor the following commitments:

1. Students will behave in a “mensch”- like manner with appropriate behavior in the classrooms, sanctuary, and other areas of the temple, and on outside field trips.
2. Respect will be demonstrated toward teachers, staff, peers and property.
3. Boys will be expected to provide their own kippot to wear during school hours. This is optional for girls.
4. Homework assignments are an integral part of our educational curriculum and each child is expected to complete and pass in homework on time.
5. Each child is personally responsible for keeping our classrooms, temple and outside areas clean and neat. All trash will be disposed of in the proper receptacles.
