### **NON REFUNDABLE REGISTRATION FEE**

We offer a discounted fee of \$75.00 per child for the non-refundable registration fee if paid before July 15, 2011. After July 15, 2011 the non-refundable registration fee will be \$85.00 per child. The family maximum non-refundable registration fee for 3 or more children is \$200.00.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL SCHOOL FEES AND TUITION MUST BE PAID IN FULL BY – SEPTEMBER 1, 2011.**

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### **BAR/BAT MITZVAH FEES**

The Bar/Bat Mitzvah fee for individualized Bar/Bat Mitzvah tutoring and for the Cantorial Soloist's participation on the day of the Bar/Bat Mitzvah is \$1200.

To reserve a Bar/Bat Mitzvah date, a \$300 deposit is required. The balance of Bar/Bat Mitzvah fees must be paid in full prior to the beginning of tutoring. The cantorial soloist will not begin tutoring until said fee is paid in full. All outstanding Temple fees must be paid in full one month prior to the Bar/Bat Mitzvah.

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### **HIGH HOLY DAY TICKET INFORMATION**

High Holy Day tickets are available for non-affiliated guests @\$100 per holiday or @\$150 for both holidays.

Temple Emanu-El members in good standing may make free arrangements to attend High Holy Day services at another Reform Congregation.
